Wah Seong Corporation Berhad is fully committed to ensure no harm to people and no damage to the environment. To this end, we have a zero tolerance policy towards injurious accidents and believe that we can achieve, and sustain, an accident-free working environment.

In line with our vision on becoming a global player in the energy infrastructure sector, we exceeded our Health, Safety and Environment (“HSE”) goals, reaching a total over 25 million manhours recorded for the last four years without fatality, recorded zero Lost Time Injury Rate (LTIR) in 2009 and achieving a 70% reduction in the Total Recordable Incident Rate (TRIR) compared to 2008.

While these improvements are encouraging, we will continue in 2010 target in maintaining zero LTI and reduction in total recordable incident rate. This will be achieved through the implementation of programs aimed at continuously strengthening our safety culture whilst simultaneously improving our HSE management systems and operational procedures.

We believe that the development of a strong safety culture is essential for the long term success of our business. Our commitment to the provision of a safe working environment for all our employees will lead to efficiency improvements, lower costs and higher productivity. Therefore, in June 2009, we have launched a pilot run on Incident Injury Free (IIF) program with JMJ Associates at PPSCI Kuantan for a period of 1 year. This program is designed to promote and embrace safety as a personal value as opposed to rules and regulations driven with full commitment from top management. To date we have seen an improvement in HSE statistic and changes to people's behaviour towards safety. This program will later be implemented throughout as we believe our journey on Incident Injury Free (IIF) can elevate and sustain our HSE performance thus creating our work place as accident free working environment.

We will continue to develop, implement and maintain management systems in which work processes are clearly defined, risks are identified and mitigated, safe working procedures are developed and all employees understand their HSE responsibilities. These systems will be compliant with the world's leading standards in safety and the environment; OSHAS 18001 and ISO 14001. In the longer term, we plan to have all of our companies certified to these standards.
